



## CALL FOR ARTISTS

*Arts In The Park* – A New Addition To Celebrate Bainbridge!  
Sunday, July 2, 2017

### Opportunity

Arts and Humanities Bainbridge is seeking volunteer artists for the first annual *Arts In The Park* event. *Arts In The Park* will feature artists painting, drawing, or sketching in a *plein air* environment. Visitors will see works of art take shape before their eyes while enjoying live music and local food and beverage selections, all in the pleasant surroundings of Waterfront Park. *Arts In The Park* is part of this year's "Celebrate Bainbridge" festivities, beginning with the Rotary Auction and culminating in the Grand Old Fourth. The event will spotlight local and regional artists and generate funds for the arts community on Bainbridge Island.

### Schedule + Details

Artists will volunteer their creative abilities, producing one or more pieces between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. on the lawn at Waterfront Park. Those newly created works will be offered at a silent auction at Raise the Roof, an arts event at BIMA from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. the same evening. All proceeds will benefit AHB's Individual Artist Fund, which enables artists in our community to pursue their passions. Artists are also encouraged to exhibit existing works. Proceeds from the sale of existing works will be shared, with the artist and the Individual Artist Fund each receiving 50%. Artists are responsible for providing their own materials and equipment. Weather protection (sun shades, event canopies) will be provided.

### Benefits

*Arts In The Park* offers a wonderful opportunity for visual artists to showcase their talents to hundreds of visitors from across the region, sell existing works, and support the arts on Bainbridge Island. AHB will issue a press release announcing the selection of artists for the event and will publicize the event and highlight participating artists on its website (including links to artist websites and other digital promotional materials), through social media, and other print publications.

### Registration Guidelines + Contact Information

*Arts In the Park* is open to any artist volunteer. It is not a juried competition. Artists may register by submitting samples of their work (no more than 5 digital images, including name, title, and medium) to AHB by email. In addition to images, artists should include a short cover letter with their contact information and a brief bio or resume for promotional purposes.
