STANDARD EDITORIAL OPTIONS

Two facing inside pages\$1100.00 (includes 3-4 hours of time)*Full page\$700.00 (includes 2 hours of time)*Half page column\$400.00 (includes 1.5 hour of time)*

DUE DATES

Reserve space by: MAY 15

Send text and images by: JUNE 1 (or sooner!)

Layout/proofing/revisions: JUNE 1-JUNE 12 (Issue goes to print June 15)

SUBMITTING YOUR TEXT (We'll let you know if any questions or concerns)

PLEASE SUBMIT TEXT IN WORD DOC FORMAT. We will review, edit as needed, and provide 1-2 proofs for review. Approximately 450 words per full page, 150-200 words per column and 75-100 words per calendar editorial quarter page.

IMAGE CAPTIONS & PHOTO CREDITS: Please include any needed captions, image credits, dates, etc., at the end of your Word doc text, and include name or number related to the image(s) that are meant to accompany. Or send such info in email content.

SUBMITTING YOUR IMAGES (We'll let you know if resolution/size is too small)

PLEASE SUBMIT DIGITAL IMAGES IN HIGH RES PRINT RESOLUTION
TWO FACING PAGES: Only 5-6 visual images + your logo and any small sponsor logos as required. (alternate image choices can be included).

FULL PAGE: Only 3-4 visual images + your logo and any small sponsor logos as required. (alternate image choices can be included).

HALF PAGE COLUMN: Only 2-3 visual images + logo & small sponsor logos as required. (alternate image choices can be included).

CALENDAR SECTION QTR PAGE: Only 1 image + logo & small sponsor logos as required. (alternate image choices can be included).

Please provide images in 300 dpi print resolution at size for print use, or as a larger image file.
